AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF LOUISVILLE, TENNESSEE, AMENDING THE LOUISVILLE ZONING ORDINANCE BE REZONING PROPERTY LOCATED ALONG LOUISVILLE ROAD (First Reading)

Mayor Bickers reviewed the proposed ordinance rezoning parcels located along Louisville Road on the former Cox property. This ordinance adjusts existing commercial zoning on these parcels to eliminate split zoning between R-1 and C-1.

MOTION by Bickers to approve the rezoning ordinance. Second by Smith. **VOTE: UNANIMOUS. MOTION PASSES**
