Present: Mayor Bickers, Alderman Smith, Alderman Pugh, Alderman Gormley, Vice Mayor Holley

Absent: None. Alderman Gormley left the meeting at 7:19 p.m. to respond to a home emergency. He returned at 7:44 p.m. No business was conducted during his absence.

Others Present: Accountants Don and Julie Teffeteller and in excess of fifty (50) citizens.

Mayor Bickers called the meeting to order at 7:12 p.m. following a one hour Public Hearing for citizen input concerning the proposed Ordinance regulating firearm discharge.

Mayor Bickers led the Opening Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

MOTION by Holley to approve the minutes of the June 12, 2018 meeting of the BMA. Second by Pugh. **VOTE: UNANIMOUS. MOTION PASSES.**

Mayor's Report and Approval of Monthly Financial Report:

MOTION by Smith to accept the June monthly financial report. Second by Holley. **VOTE: UNANIMOUS. MOTION PASSES.**

Mayor Bickers communicated information about the upcoming Kids Fishing Tournament to be held at Poland Creek on August 18. First 100 kids get a free rod & reel. Registration material is located at Town Hall and also on the Town website.

Citizens Comments: Approximately fourteen additional citizens commented on the proposed Ordinance, which would place some limits on firearm discharge within the Town of Louisville boundaries. These comments were a continuation of the Public Hearing held prior to the BMA Meeting.

MOTION by Bickers to approve the budget ordinance as amended. Second by Gormley. VOTE: UNANIMOUS. **MOTION PASSES**

Ordinance 2018-02 Passes

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF LOUISVILLE, TENNESSEE, PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURES, PUBLIC PARKS, SCHOOLS, CHURCHES AND PUBLIC ROADS (Second Reading)

Mayor Bickers proposed an amendment to the Ordinance which would strike the last sentence on **Item 4 Penalty** and modify **Item 5 Jurisdiction** accordingly.

MOTION by Bickers to amend the Ordinance as proposed. Second by Gormley. VOTE: UNANIMOUS, **MOTION PASSES**

MOTION by Gormley to approve the Ordinance as amended. Second by Smith. VOTE: UNANIMOUS, **MOTION PASSES**

Ordinance 2018-03 Passes

Other Action/Discussion Items:

1. Approval of Road Bids: Mayor Bickers and Town Engineer Swicegood reviewed the bids for the 2018-2019 Road Improvements which include paving Rankin Ferry Loop, Boatdock Road and Mentor Alley. Bids were received from APAC-Atlantic, Inc. (Harrison CC), Duracap Asphalt Paving Co. and PRI of East Tennessee, Inc. APAC was the low bidder by a significant amount. Recommendation by Town Engineer Swicegood was to place the contract with APAC.

MOTION by Bickers to award the contract to APAC-Atlantic, Inc. for the 2018 Road Improvements. Second by Gormley. VOTE: UNANIMOUS, **MOTION PASSES**

Town Engineer Swicegood will notify APAC on July 11 that they have been selected. After contract signing, the project scheduling will commence. Expectation is that the paving will be complete by the end of August 2018.
