Mayor Bickers reported on the success of the Kids Fishing Tournament held at Louisville Point Park on August 18. There were 108 kids in attendance.

Mayor Bickers communicated that the Louisville Cleanup event will be held on Saturday, September 29. This is a makeup for the event cancelled in April due to rainy weather.

Mayor Bickers communicated that the two open positions for the TOL have been filled.

**Citizens Comments:** Kay Swicegood on the worsening speeding situation on Rankin Ferry Loop and requested that the TOL implement a plan to get this situation under control. Judy and Larry Henry inquired about guidance from the TOL concerning the impact on the roads and bridge due to potential subdivision of the Lovinggood property on Miser Station Road. Patrick Surrey inquired about TOL action to improve safety at the curve on Old Lowes Ferry at Poland Creek crossing. Van Barker commented on the existing speed limit on Old Lowes Ferry Road.

**Other Action/Discussion Items:**

**1. Old Lowes Ferry Traffic Control:** Town Engineer Swicegood reviewed TOL actions to improve safety at the Old Lowes Ferry Road curve at Poland Creek crossing. The TOL has installed 20 MPH signs with flashing amber lights at both entrances into the curve. The TOL plans to purchase radar signs to provide feedback to drivers on their approaching speed. Quotes are also being secured to provide rumble grooves in the pavement along the outside white lines and the yellow center line to alert drivers to stay in their respective lanes.

**2. Report on 2018 Road Improvements:** Town Engineer Swicegood reported that all work is now complete for the 2018 Road Improvements. Harrison completed application of the required shoulder stone for a final total of 290 tons. This will be invoiced at about \$15,000, which is under the budget estimate.
